Course Outcomes

College offers B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com. The broad outcomes of these courses are:

B.Sc. Programme:

Acquire broad knowledge of science across a range of fields and demonstrate an understanding of the local and global contexts in which science is practised. To enable students to articulate the methods of science and explain that current scientific knowledge is both contestable and testable. The students would be able to apply appropriate methods of research and investigation to solve problems in Botany, Zoology, Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. The students have an option to choose between two groups: Zoology, Botany and Chemistry **OR** Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry.

B.A Programme:

B.A. programme is based on the view that there is need for an UG Programme which is relevant to the basic understanding of different disciplines of humanities and liberal arts. The courses are so designed to enable the students to acquire the basic intellectual equipment in terms of thinking ability, linguistic skills and reasonable knowledge. The students would be well equipped to pursue Masters Degree after completing this bachelor's programme.

B.Com Programme:

After completion of the three years programs Bachelors in Commerce (B.Com), students would derive a good knowledge of accounting, Finance, taxation, banking and corporate law. The three years program focused curriculum offers a number of specializations and practical exposures which would provide the student to face the modern-day challenges in commerce and business. It would enable the students to accommodate knowledge, skill and attitude that will sustain an environment of learning and creativity among the students.
